

**New City Farm Internship:**

New City Farm is a program of New City Neighbors. Our mission is to empower youth to reach their full potential. We value (1) Being Youth Centered (2) Radical Hospitality, and (3) Wholistic Ministry. We accomplish this through our main strategy: Good Food. Farm interns can specialize in vegetable production, food accessibility, leadership development, marketing, farm-to-table education, and more.

Learning opportunities:

- Cross cultural interaction with urban youth in a community development setting
- Introduction to a social enterprise model of community development
- Introduction to intensive organic vegetable growing in an urban and rural space
- Teaching youth job skills curriculum
- Faith formation
- Organizing and leading field trips
- Developing marketing strategies for our organization
- Addressing food accessibility and social justice by creating food programs that target underserved neighbors

Your Internship:

Interns will have the opportunity to choose their internship focus and will work with New City staff in an immersive and helpful environment. Interns may focus on one area in particular or work in multiple areas. However, all parts of New City Neighbors work closely together to accomplish our mission.

Support:

Interns will meet regularly with the Social Enterprise Director to ensure learning priorities are being met. This position will also have the opportunity to work closely with the Farm Coordinator and Farm to Table Educator on farm production and education projects, along with other New City Neighbors staff.

Hours:

Internships are 250 hours for the season, generally 8-16 hours a week, but can vary depending on your schedule and goals.

Compensation \$2000:

\$1000 stipend paid in two installments. Installment 1 will be paid in the middle of the internship. Installment 2 will be paid at the end of the internship. If the internship is terminated for any reason, a prorated payment shall be made.
